

Safety Procedures for Traffic Entering and Exiting from the Church Property

San Juan del Rio Church

We were notified by the St. Johns Sheriff's Office there are safety concerns with the flow of traffic to and from the Church property. As you are aware, it is extremely dark along this stretch of SR 13 in front of the Church property. The safety of the Sheriff's Deputy or PSA Officer and our parish families is paramount. The Officer directing traffic during the Wednesday evening sessions is situated in an unsafe spot in the middle of SR 13. To alleviate the congestion associated with dropping off and picking up your students, we should practice and follow a few safety rules.

Arrival: Drivers, proceeding either northbound or southbound on SR 13, must use their turn signal to indicate whether they plan to make a turn into the Church grounds.

Drivers southbound who are turning right into the Church need to wait until the Officer directs them to make the right turn, because traffic in the northbound lane may also be turning into the Church grounds.

Departure: Drivers exiting the Church grounds in either direction shall follow the same procedures. The driver shall use the appropriate turn signal to let the St. John's County Sheriff's Deputy or PSA Officer know which direction, left or right, the driver intends to turn.

Thank you for your cooperation as we continue to keep our families, the people traveling on SR 13, and the PSA Officer safe.
